## GREATER LA COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. Participants must be current Greater LA County USBC adult members. Cards will be sold on-site for $\$ 30+\$ 5$ processing fee. Local membership dues $\$ 10$.
2. This tournament shall take place on March 16-17, 2024 at WINNETKA BOWL, 20122 Vanowen St., Winnetka, CA 91306, (818) 340-5190 and on March 23-24, 2024 at KEYSTONE LANES, 11459 Imperial Hwy, Norwalk, CA 90650, (562) 8688448.
3. CLOSING DATE: March 24,2024 or when squads are full. DO NOT MAIL AFTER MARCH 11.
4. FORMAT: Team and Singles are 3 games total on the same pair of lanes. Re-entries are based on squad availability and must enter at least ONE HOUR prior to the squad time. Team must change at least 2 bowlers for re-entry. Optional AllEvents: Scores from Team and Singles + applicable handicap. All-events can only be entered when both events are bowled in one location. Only female members may enter the women's division. Singles can cash only once in the top 10.
5. HANDICAP: $90 \%$ of 220
6. DIVISIONS: Open and Women's. If there are less than 10 entries submitted in any division, the division will be cancelled. Those entries will either be refunded or moved over to the remaining division.
7. AVERAGES:
a. Highest USBC certified book average for 2022-23 (minimum 21 games), if none,
b. Highest USBC certified CURRENT average as of the tournament date (must bring league sheet, min. 21 games), if none,
c. Highest USBC certified book average for 2021-22 (minimum 21 games), if none,
d. Scratch 220

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. If a "sport" or "challenge" league average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart to determine the correct entering average. USBC rules 319a2, 319d and 319e will be waived. A bowler whose average has been re-adjusted by any tournament committee must report the readjusted average when submitting an entry. ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED PRIOR TO DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZE CHECKS.
8. Only the Team Captain may make a change in the schedule. All replacements must be made by the team captain at least ONE HOUR prior to the start of the squad. Replacements will bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced and must have current 2023-24 USBC membership. **Rule 304 Applies. BOWL.COM AVG PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ALL ENTRIES.
9. ENTRY FEES: TEAM/SINGLES: $\$ 15$ lineage $+\$ 15$ prize fund $+\$ 5$ expenses $=\$ 35$ per person ( $\$ 140$ per team). AllEvents: $\$ 10$ per person (Team+Singles). All fees must accompany this form to guarantee squad dates/times. THE OPTIONAL SCRATCH DIVISION MAY BE ENTERED ON-SITE PRIOR TO THE START OF COMPETITION. Make checks or money orders payable to: GLAC USBC. One check per entry. There will be a $\$ 35$ penalty fee for returned checks. No refunds once your entry has been scheduled. Refund requests will be reviewed by tournament management.
10. Bowlers must check in ONE HOUR prior to scheduled squad time with current 2023-24 USBC card and valid ID.
11. All prize money will be returned $100 \%$. Prize money for each location will remain separate. Prize ratio is at least $1: 8$. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Designated prize funds will be paid accordingly to each division within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings.
12. One lane courtesy only.
13. Tardy players shall receive zero for frames missed and will begin competition immediately upon arrival.
14. DRESS CODE: Dress appropriately for a championship tournament. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. NO halter tops, "cut-off's" or short shorts of any kind allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
15. ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES: Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.
16. NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER. Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
17. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
18. This tournament will be certified by USBC. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the GLAC USBC.
