**GREATER LA COUNTY USBC ASSOCIATION (GLAC USBC)
NO-TAP SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. This tournament is open to all current GLAC USBC members in good standing. GLAC USBC membership is \$30 for a standard adult card and \$15 for standard youth card. A \$5 fee will be charged per card for any on-site membership processing (excludes transfer fees). GLAC USBC local transfer cards are \$10.
2. This tournament shall take place on Saturday, May 11, 2024 at **KEYSTONE LANES**, 11459 Imperial Hwy, Norwalk, CA 90650, (562) 868-3261. **Closing date:** May 11, 2023 at 11am. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER MAY 3.**
3. **FORMAT:** This tournament will consist of three games no-tap singles on the same pair of lanes. Total pins plus handicap, when applicable, will determine the champions in each division.
4. **HANDICAP: 90% of 210**
5. **DIVISIONS:** Open or women. Only those legally designated as female may enter the women's division. All others must enter the open division. **Youth are eligible with a signed prize waiver prior to the start of competition.**
6. **AVERAGES:** The individual entering average shall use the highest of the following:
 - a. Highest **2022-23 USBC certified average** (minimum of 21 games). If none,
 - b. Highest USBC certified **current league average** (minimum 21 games) as of tournament date. League sheet must be provided. If none,
 - c. Highest **2022-23 USBC Composite certified average** (minimum of 21 games). If none,
 - d. Scratch 210

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. If a "sport" or "challenge" league average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart to determine the correct entering average. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winning will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. USBC rules 319a2 (10 pin increase in average), 319d (reporting of prize winnings) and 319e (15 pin increase in accumulated tournament average) will be waived. A bowler whose average has been re-adjusted by any tournament committee must report the readjusted average when submitting an entry.

7. **ENTRY FEE:** Prize/Scholarship: \$20 + Lineage: \$15 + Expenses: \$5 = **\$40 per person**. Make checks or money orders payable to **GLAC USBC**. Write "No-Tap" in memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$35 penalty fee.
8. **Bowlers must check in one hour prior to scheduled squad time and must show proof of membership by showing their current USBC membership card or a bowl.com printout.**
9. Replacements and walk-ins must be processed at least one hour prior to the squad time. **BOWL.COM PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED.**
10. Late bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
11. **DRESS CODE:** Dress appropriately for a tournament. Dress appropriately for a championship tournament. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. NO halter tops or short shorts of any kind allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
12. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all must be used on every delivery. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. **Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.**
13. Fees are refundable **ONLY** when the Tournament Director is notified, in writing, at least 10 days prior to the tournament date or in the case of an emergency. All refunds are at the discretion of Tournament Director.
14. All prize money/scholarships will be returned 100%. The prize ratio is based on a ratio of at least 1:8. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART under account #11334, (800) 514-2695 x3343.
15. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER.** Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
16. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
17. This tournament will be certified by USBC. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the GLAC USBC.
18. An appeal or protest of a decision involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed in writing with the tournament director and the USBC before tournament prizes are paid. The decision of USBC is final and binding on all involved parties. Any violation of tournament rules is cause for disqualification, loss of entry fee, forfeit of all prize monies and possible suspension from USBC membership.
