GLAC USBC Adult-Youth Travel League

1. All bowlers must be current members in good standing with GLAC USBC.
2. League fees are \$25 per week per person (\$16 lineage + \$9 scholarship/awards). Lineage varies per center. Any excess lineage will go towards scholarships/awards.

3. NO LEAGUE FEE SHORTAGES. THE LAST SESSION OF BOWLING MUST BE PRE-PAID BY FEBRUARY 23.

4. **FORMAT:** Trios (minimum one youth per team) bowling three games on the same pair of lanes. Team points to be earned for each game + series. Youth are aged 18 and under.

5. **HANDICAP:** 90% of 220

7. ENTERING AVERAGE:

- 1) Highest 2023-24 USBC certified book average (min. of 15 games for youth/21 games for adults); If none
- 2) Highest 2022-23 USBC certified book average (min. of 15 games for youth/21 games for adults); If none
- 3) Establish

8. All youth will earn scholarships at the end of the league. The following youth achievements will also receive awards: High average, high handicap series & game, high scratch series & game and most improved.
9. Scholarships/Awards shall be returned 100%. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART program under account #11334, (800) 514-2695 x8292.
10. **Pre-Bowls must be bowled at the scheduled center with permission from the league officers. No pre-bowls for the last two sessions (position and sweeps).**
11. Blind scores will be the bowler’s average minus 10 pins for wins and losses only. No pacers allowed.
12. One lane courtesy only.
13. Non-alcoholic drinks and food are permissible in the back area only. No tobacco or smoking products permitted by any youth bowler during league.
14. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an “X” marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.
15. **DRESS CODE:** Dress presentably for league. No alcoholic, tobacco, sexual or profane advertisements or references are allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. No workout clothes, halter tops, cut-offs or short-shorts.
16. All other league rules will be covered by the USBC Rules.
