GREATER LA COUNTY OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

- 1. Participants must be current Greater LA County USBC adult female members. Cards will be sold on-site for \$30 + \$5 processing fee. Local membership dues \$10.
- 2. This tournament shall take place on January 18, 2025 at **CORBIN BOWL**, 19616 Ventura Blvd, Tarzana, CA 91356, (818) 996-2695 and on January 25-26, 2025 at **KEYSTONE LANES**, 11459 Imperial Hwy, Norwalk, CA 90650, (562) 868-8448.
- 3. CLOSING DATE: January 26, 2025 or when squads are full. DO NOT MAIL AFTER JANUARY 13.
- 4. **FORMAT**: Four adult bowlers per team. Three games total on the same pair of lanes. Singles is virtual using team scores.
- 5. HANDICAP: 90% of 220
- 6. **DIVISION**: If there are less than 10 entries submitted, the event will be cancelled and entries will be refunded.
- 7. AVERAGES:
 - a. Highest USBC certified book average for 2023-24 (minimum 21 games), if none,
 - b. Highest USBC certified **CURRENT** average as of the tournament date (must bring league sheet, min. 21 games), if none.
 - c. Highest USBC certified book average for 2022-23 (minimum 21 games), if none,
 - d. Scratch 220

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. If a Sport or Challenge average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it must be checked on the entry form and it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart. Rules 319a2 and 319d will be waived. Rule 319c will be applied for current averages that are 20+ pins higher than last year's book. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. Re-rated averages must be reported or be subject to disgualification. ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED PRIOR TO DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZE CHECKS.

- 8. Only the Team Captain may make a change in the schedule. All replacements must be made by the team captain at least ONE HOUR prior to the start of the squad. Replacements will bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced and must have current 2023-24 USBC membership. **Rule 304 Applies. BOWL.COM AVG PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ALL ENTRIES.
- ENTRY FEES: TEAM: \$15 lineage + \$15 prize fund + \$5 expenses = \$35 per person (\$140 per team). Make checks or money orders payable to: GLAC USBC. One check per entry. There will be a \$35 penalty fee for returned checks. No refunds once your entry has been scheduled. Refund requests will be reviewed by tournament management.
- 10. Bowlers must check in ONE HOUR prior to scheduled squad time with current 2024-25 USBC card or valid ID.
- 11. All prize money will be returned 100%. Prize money for each location will remain separate. Prize ratio is at least 1:8. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Designated prize funds will be paid accordingly within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings.
- 12. One lane courtesy only.
- 13. Tardy players shall receive zero for frames missed and will begin competition immediately upon arrival.
- **14.** <u>DRESS CODE</u>: Dress appropriately for a championship tournament. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. NO workout clothing, halter tops, "cut-off's" or short shorts of any kind allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
- 15. ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES: Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.
- 16. NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER. Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
- 17. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
- **18.** This tournament will be certified by USBC. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the GLAC USBC.
