## GREATER LA COUNTY YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. All eligible bowlers must be current Greater LA County USBC youth members.
2. This tournament shall take place on February 16, 2025 at **KEYSTONE LANES**, 11459 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650, (562) 868-3261
3. **CLOSING DATE:** February 16, 2025 or when squads are full. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER FEBRUARY 9.**
4. **FORMAT:** Three games on the same pair of lanes. **TEAM:** Any 4 youth members. Order cannot be changed from original entry form. **VIRTUAL SINGLES:** Using team scores, Singles scores will processed virtually.
5. **HANDICAP:** 100% of 200
6. **AVERAGES:**
  - a. Highest 2024-25 USBC certified avg as of **February 9, 2025** (must provide league sheet, minimum 15 games), if none,
  - b. Highest 2023-24 USBC certified avg (minimum 15 games), if none,
  - c. Enter at 200

**Tournament Management has the right to adjust a bowler's entering average. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. If a "sport/challenge" average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it should be marked with an "SP/CH" in the avg box on the Entry Form. That average will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart. Rule 322b will not apply.**
7. Rosters cannot be changed from original entry. All replacements must be made by the team captain or Youth Director at least one hour prior to the start of the squad and replacements will bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced. Replacements must show current USBC membership at check-in and must bring their BOWL.com profile print-out.  
**BOWL.COM PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ALL ENTRIES.**
8. **ENTRY FEES: Team:** \$15 lineage + \$7 awards/scholarships + \$3 expenses = \$25 per person. **Virtual Singles:** \$20 awards/scholarships. Only approved refunds at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. Make checks or money orders payable to: **GLAC USBC** (returned checks are subject to a \$35 penalty fee). Walk-ins are accepted up to 45 minutes prior to the start of the squad time and only if space is available.
9. Bowlers must check-in at least one hour prior to their scheduled squad time. Please bring USBC membership cards to check-in. Squads may start earlier if everyone has checked in. All replacements must be made 45 minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Replacements must show current USBC membership at check-in.
10. **All adult volunteers (18 and over) must have and wear a Registered Volunteer badge (RVP) in order to be in the bowler's area while youth bowlers are present.**
11. **AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS:** Trophies will be awarded to the first place finishers in Team and Singles event. Scholarships will be awarded based on a ratio of at least 1:8 per event. Awards and Scholarship fees returned 100%. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART ACCT #11334, (800) 514-2695 x8292.
12. One lane courtesy only.
13. TARDY bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. A zero (0) shall be scored for all missed frames. In the event a bowler cannot finish their series, zero points will be scored the remaining frames. There shall be no BLIND scores or pacers. Rule 322b applies.
14. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers must wear attire suitable for a YOUTH championship. No alcoholic, tobacco, sexual or profane advertisements or references are allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. Not allowed: Holes in attire, halter tops, cut offs, mid-driffs or short-shorts.
15. No smoking/vaping during tournament play. Action on the lanes, which is considered unsportsmanlike or disruptive, will not be tolerated. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D) and forfeiture of any fees and awards.
16. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List. **VISIT BOWL.COM FOR RULE DETAILS.**
17. Claims of errors in score keeping must be filed with GLAC Association Manager in writing within 72 hours of the time the error was made. Protests must be filed with Tournament Management in writing within 72 hours after the close of the tournament. All decisions made by Tournament Management are final.
18. This tournament will be certified by USBC. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the GLAC USBC.
