**GREATER LA COUNTY USBC ASSOCIATION (GLAC USBC)
NO-TAP SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. This tournament is open to all current GLAC USBC members in good standing.
2. This tournament shall take place on Saturday, July 25, 2026 at **CAL BOWL**, 2500 Carson St, Lakewood, CA 90712, (562) 421-8448. **Closing date:** July 25, 2026 at 12:30pm. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER JULY 18.**
3. **FORMAT:** This tournament will consist of three games no-tap singles on the same pair of lanes. Total pins plus handicap, when applicable, will determine the champions in each division.
4. **HANDICAP: 90% of 210**
5. **DIVISIONS:** Open or women. Only those legally designated as female may enter the women's division. All others must enter the open division. **Youth are eligible to bowl with a signed prize waiver prior to the start of competition.**
6. **AVERAGES:** The individual entering average shall use the highest of the following:
 - a. Highest **2024-25 USBC certified average** (min. of 21 games). If none,
 - b. Highest 2025-26 USBC certified **current league average** (min. 21 games; league sheet required) as of tournament date. If none,
 - c. Highest **2024-25 USBC Composite certified average** (min. of 21 games). If none,
 - d. Scratch 210
7. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. If a Sport or Challenge average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it must be checked on the entry form and it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart. Rules 319a2 and 319d will be waived. Rule 319c will be applied for current averages that are 20+ pins higher than last year's book. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. Re-rated averages must be reported or be subject to disqualification.
8. **ENTRY FEE:** Prize/Scholarship: \$27 + Lineage: \$18 + Expenses: \$5 = **\$50 per person**. Make checks or money orders payable to **GLAC USBC**. Write "No-Tap" in memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$35 penalty fee.
9. **Bowlers must check in one hour prior to squad time with current USBC membership card or valid ID.**
10. Replacements and walk-ins must be processed at least one hour prior to the squad time. **BOWL.COM PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED.**
11. Late bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
12. **DRESS CODE:** Dress appropriately for a tournament. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. NO halter tops or short shorts of any kind allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
13. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.
14. Fees are refundable ONLY when the Tournament Director is notified, in writing, at least 10 days prior to the tournament date or in the case of an emergency. All refunds are at the discretion of Tournament Director.
15. All prize money/scholarships will be returned 100%. The prize ratio is based on a ratio of at least 1:8. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART under account #11334, (800) 514-2695 x3343.
16. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER.** Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
17. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
18. This tournament will be certified by USBC. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the GLAC USBC.
