SOCAL PRINCE & PRINCESS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** This tournament is open to all current USBC members in good standing with an average of 210 or less.
 2. **TOURNAMENT DATE:** Sunday, September 27, 2026. **Entries close:** 45 minutes prior to start
 3. The tournament will be held at **Alhambra Valley Bowl**, 1400 E. Valley Blvd., Alhambra, CA 91801, (626) 525-7909.
 4. **TWO DIVISIONS:** Princess: females only; Prince: open to both males and females. If a division receives 15 or less entries, the division will be cancelled. Those entrants may either move to an alternate eligible division or receive a full refund.
 5. **HANDICAP:** 90% of 210; Maximum handicap: 65
 6. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT:**
QUALIFYING: Five games, moving pairs after each game.
TOP 5 STEPLADDER FINALS: The top five bowlers in each division will advance to the stepladder finals. Any ties for seeded positions will use the highest final game of qualifying to determine the higher seeded position. If a tie still exists, the higher previous game will determine the higher seed. If a tie occurs during the finals bracket, an additional 9th and 10th frame will be bowled until the tie is broken. Champions will be crowned in each division.
 7. **The entering average shall be determined from certified USBC leagues:**
 - A. Highest **2025-26 / 2024-25 USBC certified published book average** (min. 21 games and including composite); If none,
 - B. Highest **CURRENT league average** (min. 21 games; sheet must be provided); If none;
 - C. Highest **2024-25 USBC composite average** (min. 21 games); If none;
 - D. Enter at 210
- AVERAGE VERIFICATION PRINT-OUTS FROM BOWL.COM ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL ENTRIES.**
- Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. Any falsification of the highest known average will result in immediate disqualification. If a "sport" league average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it should be marked with an "SP" in the average box and will be adjusted per the USBC Sport Chart to determine the correct entering average. Rules 319a2 and 319d will be waived. Bowlers on the USBC re-rate list must report the re-adjusted average or be subject to disqualification. **Recommended minimum average of 150.**
8. **ENTRY FEE: \$100 per person** (lineage \$40 + prize fund \$55 + expenses \$5). Starting 9/15/26, entry increases to **\$125 per person** (extra fees goes to prize fund). Check or money orders will be accepted made payable to **GLAC USBC**. Write "SoCal PP" in memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$35 penalty fee prior to competition. Make sure to include the bowler's name and event in the notes. **DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES AFTER SEPTEMBER 20.**
 9. All prize/scholarship money will be returned 100%. Prize Money/Scholarships awarded to the final top five bowlers in each division. A ratio of at least 1:8 may pay other places in each division if possible. **YOUTH AGED 14+ MUST SIGN THE USBC SCHOLARSHIP WAIVER PRIOR TO THE START OF COMPETITION.** Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART under account #11334, (800) 514-2695 x3343.
 10. Bowlers must check in one hour prior to scheduled squad time with **VALID IDENTIFICATION** and proof of USBC membership.
 11. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play with the frame then being bowled. Frames may not be made-up. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
 12. **ONE LANE COURTESY ONLY.**
 13. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. Surface changes can only be made prior to the start of competition. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. **Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.**
 14. **All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Non-denim pants and collared shirts are preferred. Skirts, shorts and skorts should extend past fingertips. All shirts must have sleeves.**
 15. This tournament is certified by USBC. The Tournament Director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes.
 16. Any violation of tournament rules is cause for disqualification, loss of entry fee, forfeit of all prize monies and possible suspension from USBC membership.
