GREATER LA COUNTY ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. Participants must be current 2026-27 Greater LA County USBC members. Cards can be purchased online at BOWL.com prior to competition (\$30). Local membership dues \$13.
2. This tournament shall take place on January 23, 2027 at **CAL BOWL**, 2500 Carson St, Lakewood, CA 90712, (562) 421-8448 and on January 24, 2027 at **SANTA CLARITA LANES**, 21615 Soledad Canyon Rd, Santa Clarita, CA 91350, (661) 254-0540
3. **ENTRIES CLOSE:** 45 minutes prior to the start of competition or when squads are full. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER JAN 16.**
4. **FORMAT:** Open Division: Four-person team format; Women's Division: Doubles format. Three games total on the same pair of lanes. Singles is virtual using team or doubles scores.
5. **HANDICAP:** 90% of 210
6. **DIVISIONS:** Two divisions: Open and Women. If there are less than 10 entries submitted, the event will be cancelled and entries will be refunded. Separate payouts for each division and location. An optional scratch division for Open Virtual Singles and Team event will be available on-site.
7. **AVERAGES:**
 - a. Highest USBC certified book average for **2025-26** (minimum 21 games), if none,
 - b. Highest USBC certified **CURRENT** average as of the tournament date (league sheet required, min. 21 games), if none,
 - c. Highest USBC certified book average for **2024-25** (minimum 21 games), if none,
 - d. Scratch 210

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. If a Sport or Challenge average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it must be checked on the entry form and it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart. Rules 319a2 and 319d will be waived. Rule 319c will be applied for current averages that are 20+ pins higher than last year's book. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. Re-rated averages must be reported or be subject to disqualification. **ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED PRIOR TO DISTRIBUTION OF PRIZE CHECKS.**
8. Only the Team Captain may make a change in the schedule. All replacements must be made by the team captain at least ONE HOUR prior to the start of the squad. Replacements will bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced and must have current USBC membership. **Rule 304 Applies. **BOWL.COM AVG PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ALL ENTRIES.**
9. **ENTRY FEES:** \$18 lineage + \$27 prize fund + \$5 expenses = \$50 per person (\$200 open team / \$100 women's doubles). Make checks or money orders payable to: GLAC USBC. One check per entry. There will be a \$35 penalty fee for returned checks. No refunds once your entry has been scheduled. Refund requests will be reviewed by tournament management.
10. **Bowlers must check in ONE HOUR prior to scheduled squad time with current 2026-27 USBC card or valid ID.**
11. All prize money will be returned 100%. Prize money for each location will remain separate. Prize ratio is at least 1:8. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Designated prize funds will be paid accordingly within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings.
12. One lane courtesy only.
13. Tardy players shall receive zero for frames missed and will begin competition immediately upon arrival.
14. **DRESS CODE:** Dress appropriately for a championship tournament. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. NO workout clothing, halter tops, "cut-off's" or short shorts of any kind allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
15. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL FOR CLEANING MAY BE USED DURING COMPETITION. No surface changes once competition begins. ELIMINATION OF BALANCE HOLES:** Bowlers may have up to five holes for gripping purposes and all holes must be used on every delivery. If only fingers are used, the thumb hole must be plugged and an "X" marked for the palm position. Any bowling ball that does not meet USBC specifications will subject the bowler to disqualification of all tournament scores. We reserve the option to do random spot checks and we may be reported to check equipment by another bowler. Visit BOWL.com to download the Non-conforming Bowling Ball List.
16. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED INSIDE THE CENTER.** Please be respectful of the hosting center's rules and guidelines.
17. This tournament will be certified by USBC. Any protest or appeal concerning scoring must be made in writing stating the grounds of the protest or appeal and submitted to the GLAC USBC tournament office within 72 hours of when the infraction occurred. The decision of USBC is final and binding on all involved parties. Any violation of tournament rules is cause for disqualification, loss of entry fee, forfeit of all prize monies and possible suspension from USBC membership.
